Ross is Professor of Political Science at the University of California, Los Angeles and Director of the Center for Southeast Asian Studies. His book *The Oil Curse: How Petroleum Wealth Shapes the Development of Nations* (Princeton University Press) was released in March 2012. Ross has published widely on the political and economic problems of resource-rich countries, civil war, democratization, and gender rights; his articles have appeared in the *American Political Science Review*; *American Journal of Political Science*, *Annual Review of Political Science*, *British Journal of Political Science*, *International Organization*, *Journal of Conflict Resolution*, *Journal of Peace Research*, *Politics and Gender*, *Quarterly Journal of Political Science*, and *World Politics*. In 2009, he received the Heinz Eulau Award from the American Political Science Association for the best article published in the *American Political Science Review*.
