

The Internship

Every year, we will provide three young Canadians with a four-month (May through August) opportunity to work in the office of a federal Member of Parliament.

Each intern will be provided with a stipend of \$2,000 per month, paid by the Internship program.

During the summer, the program will arrange meetings and discussions with people in the news media, politics, and business to help provide a rounded understanding of the political process in and around Parliament Hill.

MP's will choose the nature of the work the interns will be assigned, which could include constituency case work, policy research, writing, and general office support. The internship is not intended to be oriented towards partisan work, although we believe that positive partisanship is a constructive part of our political system.

How to Apply

The Internship is open to applications from Canadian students of a recognized undergraduate or graduate university program (which can include at institutions outside the country).

To apply, please send the following:

- A brief resume outlining education, employment and pertinent life experience
- A letter of 500-1000 words describing why you would like this opportunity
- Three letters of recommendation from people who support your application

Applications are due by **February 28** each year. Selections will be made by the end of March. Interviews will be conducted with short-listed applicants and as needed with their referees.
